- Abstract of approximately **200–250 words**
- **4–6 keywords**

Submissions should clearly demonstrate the relevance of the proposed paper to one or more EduTeachAI2027 conference tracks.

Accepted presenters may participate through appropriate conference presentation formats, including **in-person and virtual presentations**, subject to the conference program. Panel proposals and interdisciplinary contributions are particularly encouraged where they bring together different perspectives on contemporary issues in language, communication, technology and society.
